



Bronkhorst Safaris offers various Day trip options while on safari for our guest.

Limpopo offers a mosaic of superb scenic landscape, a fascinating cultural heritage, an abundance of wildlife species and many nature-based tourism opportunities. Those in search of history will find many places of archaeological significance that yielded relics dating back millions of years.

Over and above the activities that is mentioned below we also do offer several activities on site right in the comfort of our own boundaries.

Join our guides on several of the activities we do offer. Guided Game Drives, Game Walks, Night drives, Star Gazing, Target and Clay Pigeon Shooting, Archery, Birding and many more outdoor Safaris.

Town Day Trip Shopping - \$75 pp – min one person

Leave camp early morning after breakfast and drive into Lephalale. Various shops can be visited, and you will be able to see where we purchase all your food, drinks and equipment we use for your safari. Have lunch in town and head back to Camp middle afternoon. We usually schedule this activity in conjunction with a Lodge Shopping Day.

Elephant Interaction Safari - \$295 pp min 2 persons

Adventures with Elephants is about a 2-hour drive from camp. Enroute we also stop at the Cheetah Reserve. This trip could also be done on the way to camp or on the way to the airport on departure day. Various time slots are available, and we usually stick to a mid-morning slot leaving you ample time to be on time at your destination.

This amazing activity let you interact with Elephants of all ages for an unforgettable experience.

Waterberg Meander Tour – \$ 175 pp min 2 persons

Head out early morning towards the “Maun of South Africa” for a tour to see the history and culture of the Waterberg area of South Africa. So much to see but we have taken the Highlights into a day tour. The St John Church is a beautiful stone and thatch building that was designed by Sir Herbert Baker. The building was completed in 1902 and is still actively in use. Used as a spiritual sanctuary for the descendants of the early settlers and the local town's people, this church is surrounded by history. Visitors are welcome at any time during the week and to Sunday services which start at 09h30. Sir Herbert Baker designed many other glorious buildings such as the union buildings in Pretoria.

The Waterberg has inspired many artists over the decades. including Pierneef, Naude and Coetzee, and Elizabeth Hunter draws inspiration from the very same vistas, landscapes and rural scenes as the talented artists have before her. A descendant of the pioneer Davidson family, of Twenty-Four Rivers, Elizabeth lives and works on the farm, which dates to the late 1800's.

The handcrafted products of Kamotsogo are contemporary, but with a distinct and delightful African feel. Kamatsogo Craft Art, originally established in October 2006 as an empowerment project of The Clive Walker Foundation, is a social investment plan creating employment opportunity, transferring skills and empowering women through the production, marketing and sales of hand-crafted products.

We end this excursion with a visit to a Traditional Village of the Local People where bear tasting, traditional foot and dancing could be enjoyed. If this does not water your taste buttons the old renovated Vaalwater Hotel will offer you a menu and drinks of choice.

On the way back to the Lodge we will stop where you can purchase all sorts of African Curio's and trinkets to your taste.

Golfing - Pricing to be advised.

Golfing could be a safari on its own. With several Golf Courses Nearby or within an hour or 2 drive you can have your choice to preference. Ranging from the nearby Golf Course in Lephalale Town, to Zebula Golf Estate, Euphorbia Golf Estate, Legends at Entabeni and Sesambos on the Limpopo River is just a few to mention.

Palala River Excursions – min 2 person \$ 75 to \$ 175

The Palala River is a mere 10-minute drive from camp. Here you can just relax on our raft (Pontoon Boat) sipping a drink enjoying the magnificent view combined with the relaxing calm waters of this beautiful river. We always take fishing poles along for the adventures that wants to put their hands at the art of fishing. Bass, Tilapia, Carp, Catfish and several other species of fish can be targeted. We also do have smaller boats that can be used. Booking a Champagne Breakfast or just having a traditional South African Braai while on the waters can be on the menu. Hippo, Crocodile and a huge election of birds can be spotted.

Ga-Bobididi Hills Ancient Clay pots – \$ 55 min 2 pax

Situated just outside our perimeter The Ga-Bobididi Hills contains some interesting historic and ancient archaeological Clay pots. Historians claim them to be in Excess of 600 plus years. Approximate 40 min leisurely climb along an old footpath reaching this site will give you a stunning overview of our Palala valley with the Waterberg Mountains as boundary in in the South.

Bushman Paintings - \$ 75 min 2 pax

Several sites containing Bushman Paintings is dotted all over the Limpopo Valley. We do have access to some of them and this is always a very interesting excursion to do. The History of our Limpopo region is a huge treasure.

Mokolo Dam - \$ 175 min 2 pax

Mokolo Dam (previously known as the **Hans Strijdom Dam**) is a rock-fill type dam located on the Mokolo River, near Lephalale, Limpopo, South Africa. It was established in 1980. The Malmanies River and the Bulspruit River, two tributaries of the Mokolo, also enter the dam from its left side. The Dam covers around 830 Hectares and is a fishing paradise for Bass and Tilapia. Situated in the mountains It offers beautiful views with the possibility to also spot various animals like Klipspringer, Mountain Reedbuck, Impala, Kudu and Zebra. A huge selection of birds can also be spotted.

Pottery – Pricing To be advised

Let your artistic side take lead creating art out of Clay. This is a family activity for young and old. The finished products are baked and glazed and will be shipped to you.

Horse riding - \$ 125 pp min 2 pax

If you are a horse-riding fanatic or even just a beginner the options are open to enjoy the company of people who loves horses and live to teach you this activity. Riding can be done in areas adjacent to the venue with the possibilities of spotting some African Game

Palala Boutique Hotel and Spa – Pricing to be advised

Situated on the banks of the Limpopo River, the Boundary between South Africa and Botswana is this magnificent venue. Rated as the Best Spa in the world for several years this is a must visit while you are on safari with us.

Mapungubwe National Park Day Trip - \$ 325 pp – Minimum 2 persons

Depart before daybreak heading North-east past the town of Alldays to this national park with all its dramatic landscapes and historic sites. The ancient city of Mapungubwe (meaning 'hill of the jackal') is an Iron Age archaeological site in the Limpopo Province on the border between South Africa, Zimbabwe and Botswana, 75 km from Messina. It sits close to the point where the Limpopo and Shashe Rivers meet. One thousand years ago, Mapungubwe appears to have been the centre of the largest known kingdom in the African sub-continent. The civilization thrived as a sophisticated trading centre from around 1200 to 1300 AD, trading gold and ivory with China, India and Egypt. Arrive back in camp once again in time for a delicious African meal and relaxing time around the campfire. Overnight options also available in Mapungubwe.

Marekele National Park Day Trip - \$ 250 pp – Minimum 2 persons.

Depart before daybreak after coffee heading Southwest towards the Town of Thabazimbi. Marakele National Park is characterised by contrasting majestic mountain landscapes, grass-clad hills and deep valleys. Rare finds of yellowwood and cedar trees, five-metre-high cycads and tree ferns, are some of the plant species found here. All the large game species from elephant and rhino to the big cats as well as an amazing variety of birds including the largest colony of endangered Cape Vultures (more than 800 breeding pairs) in the world, have settled here. Arrive back in camp once again in time for delicious Africa meal and relaxing time around the campfire. Overnight options are also available in Marekele.

Pilanesberg National Park Day Trip - \$375 pp – Minimum 2 persons

Depart before daybreak heading Southwest to Sun City/Pilanesberg to visit one of the oldest Volcanic sites in Africa, once being the highest Mountain in Africa eroded by time and conditions to what is being turned into a worthwhile visiting game viewing and Tourist destination. This park has all the Big Five and a 2.5-hour drive from Camp. You can also opt to visit this park en-route to camp from Johannesburg. Lunch will be taken at the world renown Sun City, a mini Las Vegas in the heart of Africa. Arriving back in camp in time for dinner and all Lady Africa can offer you. Overnight options available also either in Sun City Resort or one of the various lodges in the park.

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
