




General Information



Photographic Safaris

Victoria Falls - Fly in Option - 4 days 3 nights

- Day 1 Depart midmorning from Johannesburg to Victoria Falls International Airport, transfer to Hotel. Check in. Depart for a Sunset Cruise on the Zambezi River late afternoon which includes local drinks and snacks. Leisurely a la carte dinner.
- Day 2 Visit the Falls after breakfast. Take a 15 minute Flight of the Angels over the Falls with a helicopter. Pick up for your Elephant Back Safari and Lion Activity. Dinner at the exciting Boma Place of Eating. A traditional African restaurant with entertainment and an interactive drum show. Booking of activities might differ depending on availability.
- Day 3 Breakfast. Full Day Botswana Safari on the Chobe river with a Game drive. Dinner at the Hotel.
- Day 4 After Breakfast you can do final curio shopping before catching the bus to the Airport for departure to Johannesburg.







Victoria Falls - Fly in Option - 3 days 2 nights

- Day 1 Depart midmorning from Johannesburg to Victoria Falls International Airport, transfer to Hotel. Check in. Depart for a Sunset Cruise on the Zambezi River late afternoon which includes local drinks and snacks. Leisurely a la carte dinner.
- Day 2 Visit the Falls after breakfast. Take a 15 minute Flight of the Angels over the Falls with a helicopter. Pick up for your Elephant Back Safari and Lion Activity. Dinner at the exciting Boma Place of Eating. A traditional African restaurant with entertainment and an interactive drum show.
- Day 3 After Breakfast you can do final curio shopping before catching the bus to the Airport for departure to Johannesburg.

- Day 1 Depart Bateleur Tented Safari Lodge (PBS Home base) early morning (5 o'clock) after breakfast to be at the Botswana border post when it opens.
 Drive through to Elephant Sands just outside of Nata. Dinner and overnight. Daily Cost per person per Safari Quote.
- Day 2 Depart for Victoria Falls via Kazangula Border Post. Arrive in time for Lunch. Continue with Scheduled Safari Program. Final Day, Depart after breakfast from Victoria Falls back to Bateleur Tented Safari Lodge. Dinner and Overnight. Daily Cost per person as per Safari Quote.


Take your level of photography to the next level. Phillip Bronkhorst Safaris now also offer you the unique opportunity to explore your passion as wildlife photographer.



Philip Bronkhorst Safari's understands the true nature of the hunt. Phillip provides the opportunity for all of us to experience the richness of hunting Africa.





Additionally, we didn't want to accompany them on the stalk as that would have added pressure on a twelve year old new hunter. Luckily both of them bonded and the result was six out of seven one shot trophies. Only about half of the stalks were successful and that was a good thing as he learned it was hunting and not just shooting.

His dad, mom, and I watched his skill and confidence level grow exponentially. He reduced the time to set the sticks, mount the gun, acquire the sight picture in the scope and make the shot by about 75%. This experience would have taken years here in the USA.
